PLEASE NOTE: If your pet receives a vaccine today they may run a low grade fever for a few days. It is important that you keep your pet in a warm, dry environment for 48 hours after receiving a vaccine.

Your pet has received one or more vaccines today to protect him or her from potentially fatal diseases. Your diligence and care in providing these life saving vaccines in a timely manner is appreciated by your pet's doctor, veterinary care staff, and of course your pet.

Although these vaccines are safe, occasionally pets may experience one or more of the following conditions due to a general vaccine reaction:

- Mild lethargy
- Muscular soreness
- Decreased appetite
- Mild fever
- Mild vomiting and diarrhea

These mild reactions usually don't last more than 24 hours. If your pet exhibits any of these symptoms, or they persist longer than 24 hours, call the medical team to discuss them. Rarely pets exhibit more serious conditions soon after vaccinations including:

- Swelling of the face or ears
- Hives or significant itching
- Difficulty breathing
- Significant lethargy
- Significant vomiting or diarrhea
- Fluid build up or infection at the injection site

If your pet exhibits any of these signs bring him or her to the emergency clinic immediately. He or she may need medications to treat the reaction. Please contact Veterinary Referral Hospital of Hickory at (828) 328-6697. Such reactions cannot be predicted ahead of time.

Occasionally pets that have received injectable vaccinations develop a localized reaction indicated by a small, hard lump under the skin where administered. These may take 1-3 weeks to appear and 2-6 weeks to resolve, and usually don't require treatment.

Pets that received a Rabies vaccination may develop a small bald spot over the vaccination site. Please contact the medical team if this occurs. These spots are merely cosmetic and may be permanent in rare cases. Treatment may reduce this possibility.

Pets receiving the nose drop for Bordetella (Kennel Cough) vaccination may experience a mild upper respiratory reaction approximately 5-7 days later. These pets may have a very mild sneeze or runny nose for 2-3 days.
